



1. Download the .zip file and unzip to a folder on your computer



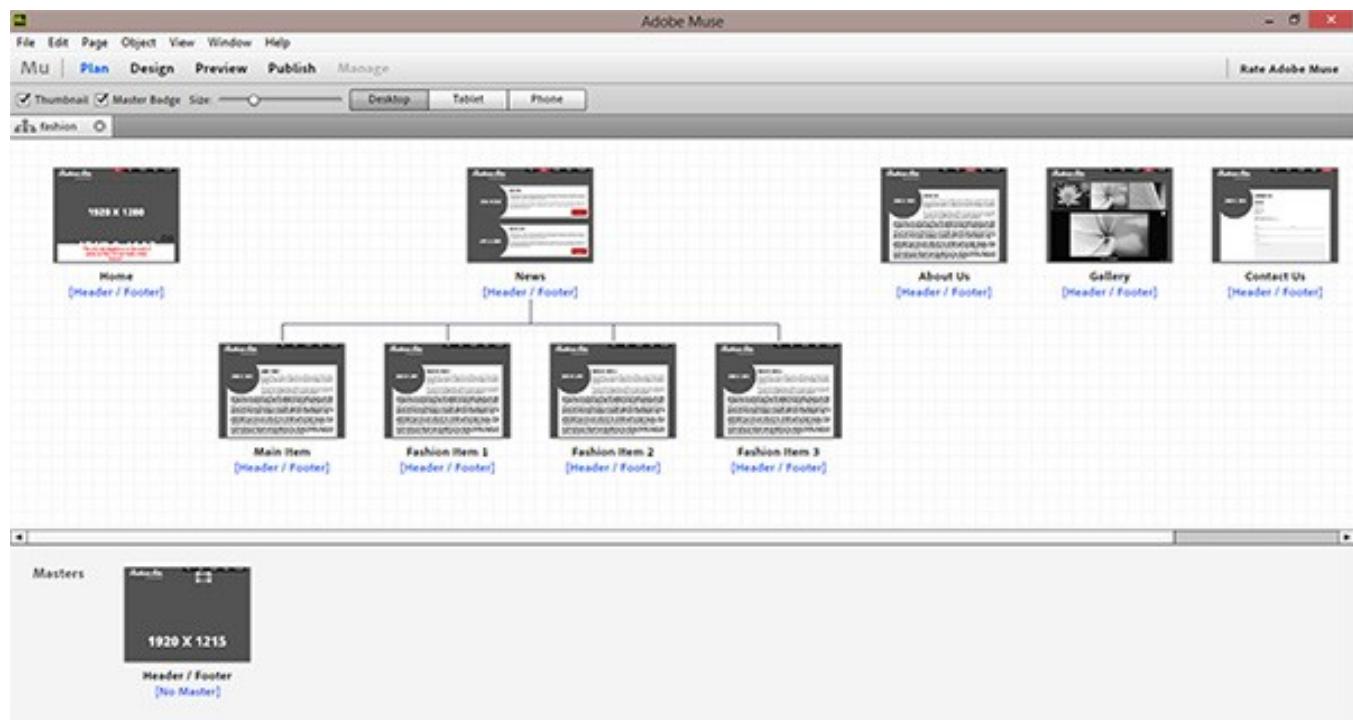

2. Find the folder you and find the .muse file, double click this file

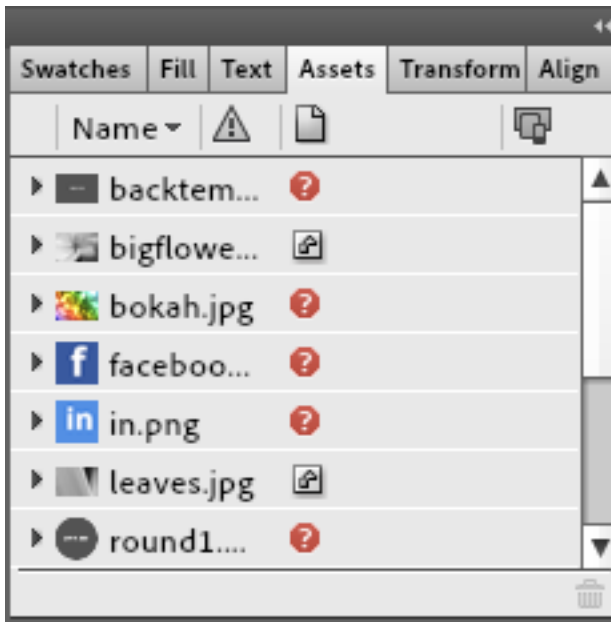

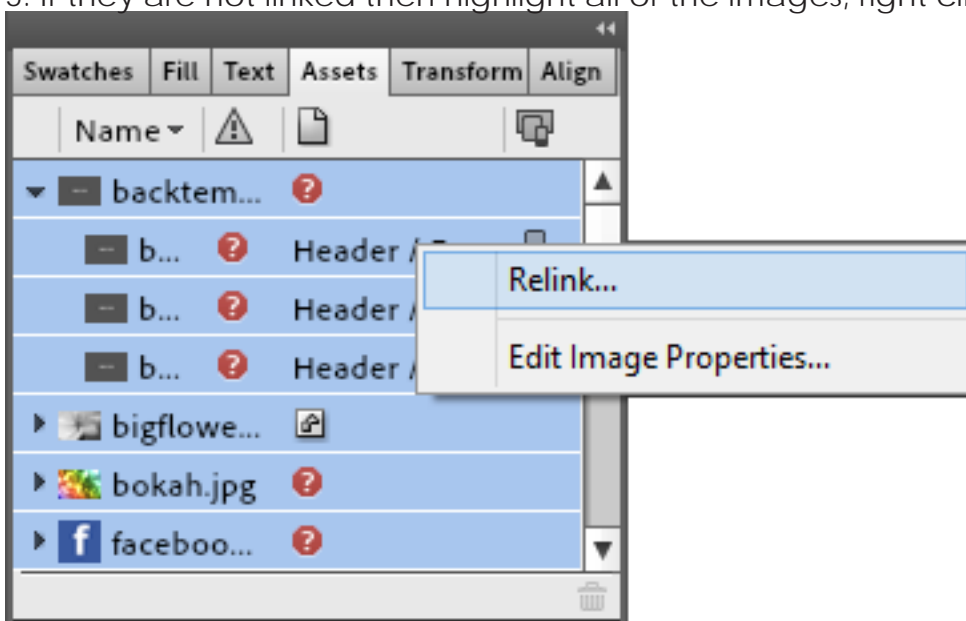
3. Your theme will open in Muse



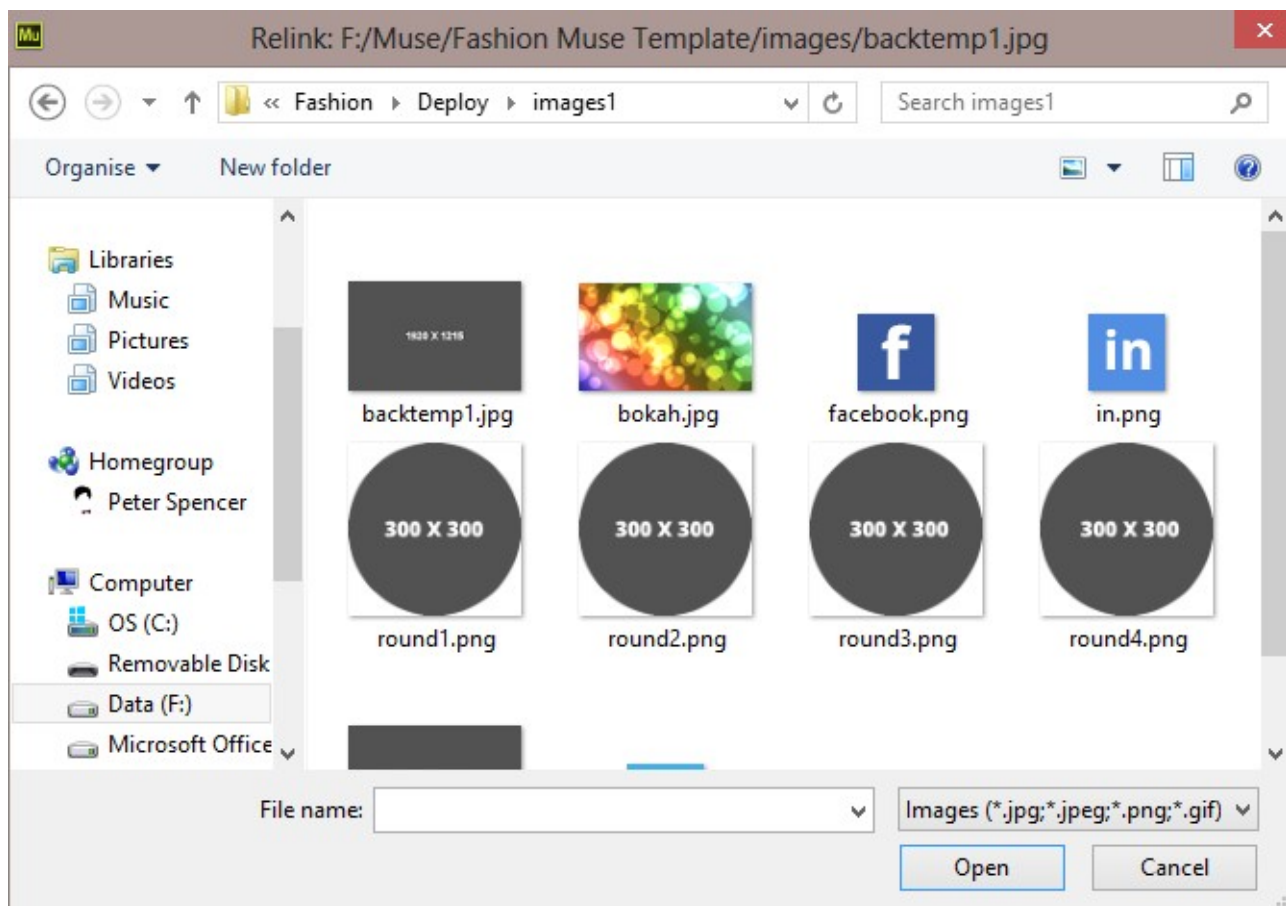
4. Open the first page and click the assets tab and ensure that the files are all linked correctly



5. If they are not linked then highlight all of the images, right click and click RELINK



6. Find the first file that the theme requires linking, click and press open, if the rest of the files are in this folder it will automatically relink them.



7. If any place holder images are used you will find a link and item number of the image used in the demo site in the imagesused.txt file in the zip file
8. Open the place holder and image in Photoshop or similar editing program
9. Copy the image in to the place holder and re-position as necessary
10. Save and go to the assets folder and click update asset
11. You can import the widgets from the library folder and use these to create new pages
12. If you are using the HTML files, do a search in the files for [www.yourdomian.com](http://www.yourdomian.com) and replace with your domain name. This will ensure your files link correctly and site map is correct. Please note this only applies to the HTML files and your can always export these again from the original Muse file by going to FILE > EXPORT AS HTML
